General:

- 1. Today we had design presentations from Costumes, Scenic and Sound.

Scenic:

1. The color palette is inspired by a painting by Paul Cadmus. Lots of browns and tans. Muted tones. Focusing on secondary colors.

- 2. NYC setting will feel like "real, gritty New York." One should feel "inundated" by the buildings.
- 3. The newsstand will feel dilapidated and gritty.
- 4. Mission should also feel "grimey."
- 5. Distressed, rose-colored curtains will be used for Hot Box.
- 6. Havana color palette is inspired by 1950s Cuban art.
- 7. There will be café tables and chairs in the Havana scenes.
- 8. The "entrance" to the Sewer is a manhole cover upstage.
- 9. The escape stairs offstage for the fire escape unit will most likely be a straight ladder.
- 10. Only one person can be on the front of the fire escape unit at a time.
- 11. Please see Lighting Note #2.

12. Thank you for the lovely design presentation today, and thank you to the assistants for creating that awesome model!

Lighting:

- 1. Colors will be "flatter" to go along with the muted tones in the scenery.
- 2. There will be footlights on the edge of the deck for the Sewer and Hot Box scenes.
- 3. Hot Box will have a "seamier, beat-up" vibe. Still bright and colorful, but it's been around for awhile. Not as classy as it once was.
- 4. Hot Box look will have bright, saturated colors to contrast with the more subdued, grittier NYC look.
- 5. Havana will not be subdued at all and will be brighter than the Hot Box look.

6. Sewer will have a sense of being an enclosed space, and will have a grate or something else overhead (to show that they're under a street) to allow street light in.

Sound:

- 1. All actors will be mic'd.

- 5. Rep plot will be used.
- 6. Orchestra will be approximately 20 people.
- 7. It would be great if baffling could be loaded in before quiet time.
