3. The balloons will be made to be more stable.

4. The burger bag is a good size.

5. The corn starch for the light explosion effect will be ready for tomorrow.

6. We will be using a fresh boom box tomorrow.

Lighting:

1. Kerry, Paul, and Justin will enter in black on stage left during Chaplain's monologue before we switch to the recording.

2. The dark spot upstage in the Justin/Renata scene will be fixed.

Costumes:

1. Rachael would like Renata to keep her Nike shoes on during her first scene and instead to take off her zip-up sweatshirt.
