

Production Meeting Notes

Location: Semel Theater

General:

1. No General Notes at this time, thanks!

Director & Choreographer:

- 1. Coordinate with Stage Management to schedule Magic Rehearsal.
- 2. D. Klingenstein will be in Puppeteer costume at TOS.
- 3. Deadline for notes in program is 10/4.

Scenic:

- 1. Will look into putting a hook into the deck for the James "jumping" off the deck of the peach moment.
- 2. Leaning towards using a spring-loaded gate rather than a rope to block off the HL and HR stairs.
- 3. Hole or something like that in deck for Magic Flagpole placement.
- 4. Boardwalk/Queen Mary railings will get scaled down.
- 5. Will provide PSE with hardware to rig speaker DSL.

Lighting:

- 1. Please see notes about comm meeting coming along this weekend.
- 2. Still within the budget!
- 3. Please see Prop Note #7.

Costumes:

- 1. Emily is exchanging the men's shoes.
- 2. Production Management will assist in coordinating moving the wig dryer.
- 3. Will send updated shoe list to Stage Management.
- 4. Ladybug's purse may need to be smaller.
- 5. Please see Director Note #2.

Puppets:

- 1. 2D Cow puppets will have 2 cows per puppet.
- 2. Fence puppet will be operated with 1 rod.
- 3. Scenic will try to make 2D Airplane puppet double-sided.
- 4. 2D Peach puppet will be 18"-16" large. We'll see how it looks with the 2D Seagull puppets.
- 5. Please keep SM and Director updated on whether or not 2D Queen Mary puppet can be painted double sided. Queen Mary puppet will be operated with 1 rod.
- 6. There will be 1 single 2D Shark puppet and 1 2D group of 3 sharks puppet.
- 7. 2D Cliffs of Dover is operated with 1 rod.
- 8. The 2D Wonka Factory puppet will have 2 rods and operated by 1 puppeteer. TBD if it will break apart cleanly or jagged.
- 9. The 2D Seagull puppets will have 4 seagulls in each group and operated by 1 rod.
- 10. 2D Ocean Wave puppet can be operated by 1 puppeteer.
- 11. 2D Motorcycle puppet with James attachment will need 2 operators.
- 12. Still figuring out how exactly the spider web is going to attach to the 2D Seagull and 2D Peach puppet. Leaning towards magnets and a soft material for the spider web.
- 13. Please keep Stage Management updated for when we can get some of these 2D puppets into rehearsal!
- 14. We'd like for the rods to be painted black, and be 1/2 round with the part that attaches to the puppet to be the flat side.
- 15. The Seagulls on the Seagull Mobile puppet will be parallel to the hooks the "spider web" will loop on to.

Props:

- 1. The Magic Growing "Peach" has arrived! Still needs a paint job but it's fun to have now!
- 2. The metal magic canes have been ordered and will arrive sometime next week.
- 3. Working on ideas to accomplish how Spider can produce the six 12' lengths of paracord.
- 4. Will meet with OA to explore possibility of using wireless DMX.
- 5. The more times the Magic Flagpole the more likely it will look less "solid" to the audience.
- 6. Motorcycle needs a new throttle, auxillary battery will be kept in one of the saddlebags.
- 7. Sign will be attached to lamp post via magnets. Will this interfere with wireless DMX?
