SCENIC

- 1. We would like the actors to be able to cross the top row, even with all the stuff there if possible.
- 2. We ideally will need the entire gallery to be open for the actors to walk around and we will be storing props/instruments up there.
- PROPS
 - 1. We are hoping to ADD water bottles for the actors. These can range from Nalgene's to canteens to plastic water bottles.
 - 2. Could we ADD 3 more crates? Any material is welcome.
 - 3. The leather strap for the stirrup on Chuckles (the rocking horse) broke today. We do not need this mended, but we thought you should know.
 - 4. Can we stiffen the neck of the child lifejacket? When we are carrying it as a child the neck looks broken.

COSTUMES

- 1. Thank you for joining us and bringing more stuff! We will always take more clothing!
- 2. Just a reminder that everyone will be stepping up 18" frequently on the set. Costumes must allow for this as an easy movement.
- 3. Can we replace/add to the Velcro on the Grusha Shawl with a button or clasp? We don't particularly like the sound of Velcro, but we do need a sturdier closure.
- 4. In thinking about the movement and the set, we believe it may be best for ALL actors to have shoes on in order to assure their safety.
