3. Arlie dumps the scrambled eggs in the toilet and puts the plate in the toilet sink. We may need to cover the toilet hole to clean the eggs out after the show.

4. Evans and Caldwell both sit on the kitchen table at the same time.

5. Thanks for the chairs! The old chairs are in front of the prop shop.

6. Please see Scenic Note #3.

7. On page 5, Arlie drops the brick for the break-in from standing up on the metal chair on the bar grating stage right. We are concerned about the brick withstanding the drop.

8. We have been using the studio tables to represent the sink and counter unit. Actors have been playing with leaning on/sitting on the counter. Maureen likes this height, which is 29".
