- 4. The dimensions we decided on for the Juvie cot are 5'6" long, 20" wide, and 18" tall (to the top of the mattress). As we talked about, the mattress gets pulled up and we see a bunch of stuff hidden underneath it. Maureen and Lisa will be looking at screw-in, metal Ikea legs (about 14" tall). We only really care about the downstage legs being metal.
- 5. The apartment bed should be 23" tall to the top of the mattress.
- 6. Maureen and Lisa discussed having a spare chair in the apartment between the sideboard and the coatrack to use in case the grey one that gets thrown multiple times happens to break.
- 7. The grocery bag does not have to break. Arlene tripping and everything falling is enough.
