5) Script Changes

1. Page 21: CUT **ARLENE:** "I ain't got a can. Just leave it. **MOTHER:** And have you sweep it under the bed after I go?"

Scenic

- 1. Both doors should not close on their own. They should be able to remain open.
- 2. Please see Props Note #7.
- 3. Mother scrubs the floor with a wet sponge in multiple spots. As of today's rehearsal, she does not scrub the wall.

- Forks/Knives/Napkins in the dinner scene should come contained in one of those little plastic sleeves. Both Arlene's and Bennie's will be opened and crumpled every night. These crinkle loudly.
- 2. Please see Costumes Notes #1 and #2.
- 3. The bread box is too large for the amount of space we have. Can we get something smaller?
- 4. Carl knocks the grey chair onto its back.
- 5. Maureen loves the afghan you gave us!
- 6. Thank you for the coatrack!
- 7. Instead of scraping the nailpolish off the floor with a razor blade, we currently have Mother scrubbing it off with a sponge and water.
- 8. Can we have doors on both the under-sink and under-counter storage space?
- 9. Pleas see Scenic Note #3. Mother also scrubs the top of the counter with a wet sponge.
- 10. The sponge we have in rehearsal should not be the show prop. We need a real, squishy sponge.
- 11. On p. 20, Arlie fills up the bucket Mother has brought with water. On p. 21 she dumps the bucket in the bathroom. Please see Sound Note #1. Will she physically be pouring water or would it be best for a duplicate bucket?
- 12. We blocked the Bennie/Arlene chicken scene today and used the two-liter plan. This means we should have the two liter, as well as two cups (from KFC)
- 13. The KFC sack should be large.

- 1. pg. 50, Carl removes his watch and throws it at the sideboard. Watch should be durable as he throws it pretty hard and it ricochets off the sideboard and across the floor.
- 2. The towel that Arlene wears out of the shower is the same towel that has been removed from her trunk from prison. Lisa received the note that this should have some sort of Pine Ridge marking on it. As this towel is worn for a while onstage, we are considering it a costume and would like Lauren's design.

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4. Emily and Bre have been discussing ideas about stick-and poke tattoo(s) that Arlie/Arlene may have. We also discussed that Arlene especially would probably have wounds, burns, and scars.

5. Mother enters for her scene with a jacket. She takes this off and hangs it on the coat rack. Is this a different piece from her sweater?
