REHEARSAL DESCRIPTION:

Stage Management stepped out of the room in order for these conversations and character work to be low pressure, but it seemed that they both were very successful. After the one on one session's we dove into more blocking of Act II. We blocked 2.4 Shitty Shit, 2.2 Wine & Dine, and even started blocking on 2.6 Guilt which wasn't originally on the schedule. We ended the day with some cleaning and scene work on 1.7 Big Shot and 1.5 This Fool.

- 5. 2.2 We would like the menus to be thin hard cover booklets. Preferably $\frac{1}{2}$ the width and not quite as long as the thin menus we currently have.
 - Benny has borrowed similar menus in the past from a fancy restaurant in Harvard Sq.
- 6. 2.6 Could we make the coffee table smaller than on the groundplan (like the table that has been added to Liz's office) and placed between the two middle chairs instead of downstage of them? Also noted in Scenic.
- 7. 2.6 Would it be safe to lightly toss Coach Jones's cell phone onto a table or chair?
