3. Is there string to use for the coin purse to make it wearable on the actor's necks?
4. Are the stools on stage able to be knocked over during the performance?

1. Martin will no longer be making his change into his "pope outfit" on stage so this no longer has to be a quick change or part of the same outfit as his normal Act II look.
2. Does Peasant Woman have a pocket or some kind of pouch to hold her penny in during her entrance in Act II?
3. There were several pins still in Marie's sack that were discovered during rehearsal today. No one was seriously injured, just a few light scratches and the bag was torn. Stage Management will be bringing it in to the shop tomorrow to be looked at.
